

Youth Pastor position for Gateway Community Church, Hinton, Alberta.

The Youth Pastor is expected to work a minimum of 40 hours per work week. This may include up to three evenings per week (including weekends)

Primary duties of the Youth Pastor include.

Lead and facilitate Youth Ministry.

This includes

- Seeking to use the Youth Ministry as a means of discipleship and spiritual growth for the glory of God the good of his church and the good of all people.
- To engage and disciple the youth of Hinton and our church through regular youth meetings as well as bible studies, retreats, local outreach and missions trips.
- Overseeing/leading the organization of events and studies ensuring that they are properly planned and led.
 - Providing mentoring and discipling of youth leaders and students to drive them to Christ.
 - Development of a team and training of leaders.
 - Providing appropriate, and biblically sound, study materials.
 - Work with Parents of youth to facilitate spiritual and emotional growth.
 - Ensure good communication with Parents.

Lead and facilitate Young Adults group Ministry.

This includes.

- Seeking to use the Young Adults Ministry as a means of discipleship and spiritual growth for the glory of God the good of his church and the good of all people.
 - Ensuring these are planned and properly led.
 - Overseeing/leading the training and appointment of leaders.
 - Providing appropriate, and biblically sound, study materials.

Other duties may include:

Pastoral Care of the congregation through visitation, counselling and prayer as encouraged by the Lead Pastor.

Preach and teach as needed and/or in agreement with the Lead Pastor.

Participation in and preparation for Sunday Services as directed.

Attendance of special events i.e. Graduations, funerals or other events significant in the life of the church and those under his charge.

Shall seek personal development and education through courses seminars, conferences etc.

Gain education or training in small groups ministry which would be beneficial for the Youth Pastor as leader and for the church in general.

Participation in BGCA events, cluster groups, and meetings that are deemed beneficial and as time permits.

Development of leaders and future leaders for those ministries under his care.

Willingness to conduct weddings, funerals, baptisms, dedications, or other events as well as any classes associated with these, as directed through the Lead Pastor, in accordance with Biblical standards and as time permits.

Additional Expectations .

Spend time in Scripture and in Prayer.

Submit a statement of goals for the upcoming ministry year (September to August) to the Lead Pastor.

Practice good communication with the Lead Pastor and staff.

Work with Lead Pastor and Board of Elders in developing and evaluation of the vision for Gateway.

Have signed and be in agreement with the BGC Code of ethics.

Regular Involvement in staff meetings.

Attendance at board and congregational meetings.

Other Duties as requested by the Lead Pastor.

Meet regularly with the Lead Pastor to co-ordinate ministry demands, foster accountability and for mutual edification and prayer.

The Youth Pastor is directly responsible to the Lead Pastor. Should there be no Lead Pastor; The Youth Pastor will be directly responsible to the Chairman of the Board of Elders and this description may be tailored to meet the need of the church, until a Lead Pastor is determined.
