Is Your Church Poised for Renewal?

One of our sessions at Celebration next month at Camp Nakamun is on the question of Church Revitalization. As I travel across our Conference I meet many pastors and churches seeking the Lord for next steps in their congregation. Recent statistics say that of Churches that are 20+years old: 60% choose to do nothing to change, 20% might try something, 20% will make effort and half of those will see transformation. What kind of church is ready to go on a spiritual journey that could lead to sustainable transformation?

5 factors a church needs to have for revitalization journey

- 1. The Pastor is key. They need to be ready, able, willing and leading. They have to know their gifting, talents and shortcomings. They need to be the initiating force.
- 2. A group of positive lay people who "get it" and who are willing to participate
- 3. The belief/conviction that God is truly up to something to in the church.
- 4. They have adequate resources or practical support at their disposal to help them make forward progress.
- 5. A sense of God's timing. They need to recognize when doors are open, and when doors are closed.

The desire of my heart is to see our churches fulfilling all God has for them. If you want to pursue revitalization please contact us for information on how to intentionally engage in this process.
