BGC National Office is working on a HR manual that will be available in the new year. It is full of policies, job descriptions and guidelines to help you navigate hiring, training, discipline and even dismissal. The manual will be comprehensive but each church could excerpt the policies that best suits their needs. We believe this is a practical way for us to serve our churches.
