It is deeply moving for me when the bugler plays the Last Post and the lines of Robert Binyon's poem are read:

They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old:
Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn.
At the going down of the sun and in the morning,

They were staunch to the end against odds uncounted, They fell with their faces to the foe.

Dr. Roger Helland's Resignation

Dear friends and fellow leaders of Canadian Baptist Seminary and the Baptist General Conference of Canada,

I regret to inform you that I have recently announced my resignation as president of CBS to the board of regents. I gave all I had for three very intensive months. I came into the role as president of CBS with many assumptions mingled with many affirmations. However, after much prayer, thought, evaluation, looking at facts and my limitations, and talking with my wife Gail, I concluded that I simply and regretfully cannot do what it takes to lead a revitalization effort for CBS. I know this comes suddenly and unexpectedly as we all had optimistic hopes for me in accepting the invitation to serve in this role. Thanks for your understanding, prayer, and support. My heart for theological education will continue.
